

## RED FLAG REFERENCE SHEET

All staff participating in the enrollment process will create red flag at application for families with identified or suspected health, nutrition, disability, or mental health concerns:

### Health

- Chronic Illness: asthma, seizures, eczema, diabetes, sickle cell anemia, cystic fibrosis, orthopedic concerns
  - Asthma: under current medical treatment for condition. Follow Up with Parent Asthma Assessment and protocol.
  - Eczema: also request any special lotions, soaps to be used for child, and what if any triggers are present for child.
  - Seizures: Date, Length, Last Occurrence. Follow up with Parent Seizure Assessment
- Acute Illness/Past: heart condition (for which child is currently being monitored), cancer
- Allergies: pet or environmental
- Toileting Issues
- Frequent ear infections within the two years
- Medications: Epipen, Abluterol, Creams, Insulin

### Nutrition

- Chronic nutrition concerns: Diabetes
- Diet Restrictions: Kosher Diet, vegetarian, no pork
- Food Allergies: peanuts, milk, or any noted foods
- Anemia: Hgb  $\leq$  11.3g/dL or Hct  $\leq$  34%, or as noted on Physical Exam
- Weight Concerns: >95% or < 5%, Failure to thrive, overweight, or any concerns noted on physical exam

### Disabilities

- Speech delay or impairment: suspected or diagnosed
  - **If diagnosed provide a copy of the IFSP/IEP**
- Premature birth: 32 weeks or earlier 7 months gestation or earlier
  - Inquire from parent if child received early intervention services and **then obtain documentation**
- Diagnosed or suspected (parental/health care provider) developmental delays which may include motor, vision, hearing, missing limbs, etc.
- Any child with an IFSP/IEP
- During in-take ask the parent if they have any concerns regarding the child's overall development

### Mental Health

- Restraining order (attach any court documentation)
- Foster Child/Kinship Care (attach any legal custody documentation)
- Behavioral concerns (suspected by parents or identified)
- Parenting concerns

### Other

Refusal for screenings (Nutrition, Behavioral, Referrals, Health Services/Screenings, Developmental screenings)
